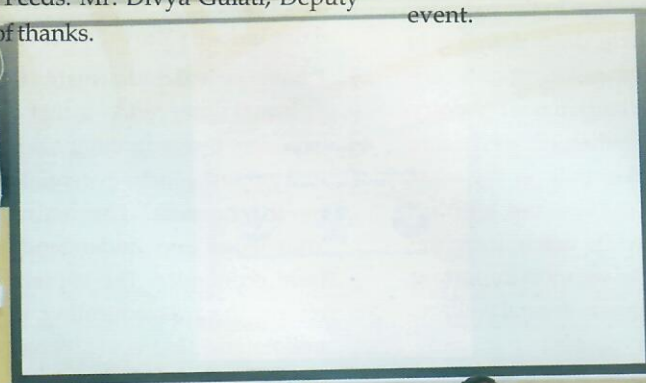

Dried Distillers Grains Solubles (DDGS) is protein source produced by ethanol manufacturers. Rice of Maize is used for ethanol and DDGS production. Rice DDGS contains 43-45% protein and maize DDGS contains 26-28% protein. It can be used at 1-5% inclusion levels in animal feeds. Moisture should not be more than 11% and it should be free from aflatoxins. It should not be over-processed.



Dr. Udeybir Singh Chahal, Head and Professor, Department of Animal Nutrition and President, ANSI played important role in organizing it. Dr. Dinesh Bhosale was the master of ceremony. Around 150 participants from various sectors attended the event.
