

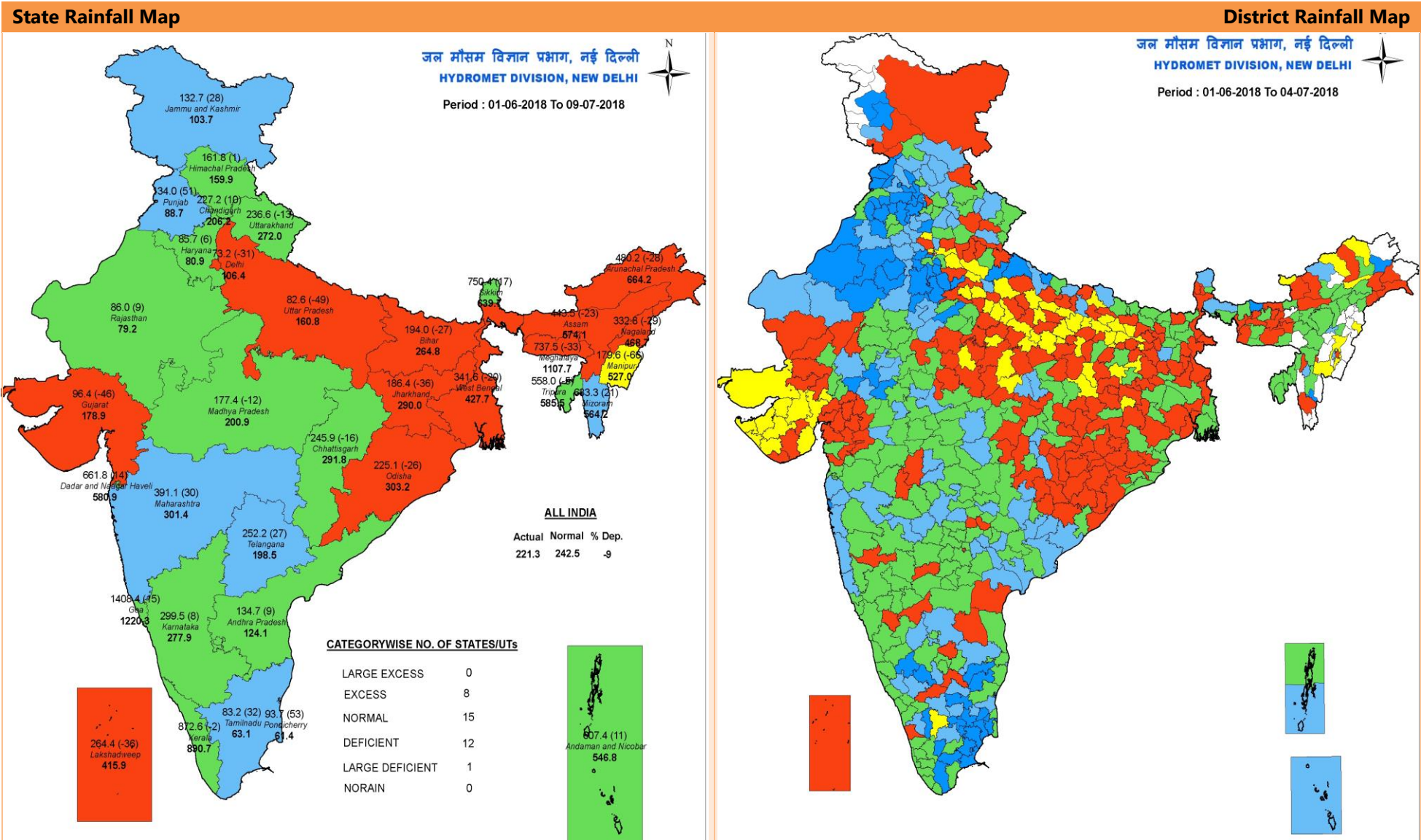

- Ongoing active monsoon conditions are very likely to continue over central India and south Peninsula during next 5-6 days.
- Rainfall activity is likely to increase over parts of northwest India during next 48 hours.
- Subdued rainfall activity is likely to continue over East and Northeast India during next 4-5 days.
- A second surge of monsoon rain is expected to take place across northern and western India this week.
- Across India, heavy rainfall will target parts of the west coast and central interior through the week
- Heavy rains are likely over Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, parts of Vidarbha and Konkan & Goa.
- In fact, spells of heavy rains may trigger flooding as well.
- Meanwhile, South Gujarat and Southeast Rajasthan would see light to moderate Monsoon rains.
- Rain In Delhi Likely Today: India Meteorological Department said it will be a generally cloudy sky towards the afternoon or evening with light rains or thundershowers
- Mumbai Rain Updates: Mumbai School, Colleges Shut Due To Heavy Rain.
- **South Interior Karnataka**- Long duration crops like pigeonpea, and castor has been sown, undertake earthing up. Recommended for medium to short duration crops like ragi, maize, groundnut, cowpea and greengram, Black gram.
- **North Interior Karnataka**- Take up sowing of kharif crops like Black gram, Soybean, Maize, Bt. Cotton, Redgram, Bajra, Sesamum, Navane and Groundnut.
- **Andhra Pradesh**-Farmers of Chittoor, Kadapa, Kurnool, Ananthapuramu districts are advised to take up sowing of rainfed groundnut only after receipt of sufficient rainfall.
- **Madhya Maharashtra** - Sowing of pearl millet can be undertaken up to 15th July.
- **Rajasthan**- farmers can go for sowing of maize, soybean, bajra, sorghum, groundnut within 1-2 days. Farmers are advised for sowing of bajra and cluster bean in western and eastern parts of the state.
